ERASMUS EXCHANGE

- Most popular and wide-spread exchange programme in Europe
- Offers study abroad opportunities or intl. internship opportunities
- Very inclusive (no limitations as to citizenship or age)
- If selected, you will be awarded a grant to help you fund your studies abroad
- 80+ partner universities of the Faculty of Humanities
- The main selection procedure happens in February (apply for winter or summer semester of the next academic year)
- Additional selection procedure may be held in September (apply for summer semester of the same academic year)

- Students can apply only for one semester (extension is possible)
- BA students must be actively studying and must be enrolled at least in the 2nd year, at most in their 4th year to study abroad
- Erasmus cannot interfere with your study obligations at the Faculty!

- Make sure that you have sufficient funds to cover all of your expenses
- You can request <u>some funds</u> (see next slide) help you cover the expenses to

- Always make sure that the particular programme accepts English speakers or non-Czech citizens
- Make sure that you fulfill all the visa requirements before you go abroad
- While abroad, you are not excused from paying the tuition fees here at the Faculty.

NOTE: WE RECOMMEND OUR BA STUDENTS CHOOSE THE ERASMUS PROGRAMME. The abovementioned programmes are intended mainly for our MA and PhD students.

FINANCING YOUR STUDY ABROAD STAY

Scholarships are intended to support international mobility and cover some of the financial costs of study-abroad stays

- <u>Mobility Fund</u> mostly for long study stays (e.g. through bilateral university agreements)
 - Support student exchange, the participation of students of the University in international study and professional events, and the international exchange of academic and scientific staff
 - Deadlines are usually in the beginning of **October** and **March**
- **<u>POINT</u>** short stays (e.g. summer schools)
 - One of the supporting tools of financing activities aimed to increase the level of internationalisation at Charles University.
 - Deadlines are usually in **October** and **February**

- Specific group of **optional** courses organized in cooperation with our partner institutions which you can find among courses in English provided at the Faculty
 - UPCES Undergraduate Program in Central European Studies
 - CET Central European Studies and Jewish Studies
- These course have an earlier beginning of the teaching period!
- You will find them in the course catalogue under "YBAU" and "YBAC" codes
